



Colour coded books

Children are grouped by their phonics level. Each half term teachers will assess and rearrange groups as needed.



Colour coded books

Children will bring the book home that they have been reading at school. It is important that they read at home every day.

English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- 26 letters
- Over 150+ graphemes (letter combinations)

One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.

Activity 1: Speed Sounds

Speed sounds

Each box contains one sound but sometimes more than one grapheme. Focus graphemes are circled.

Activity 3: Read the story


"Get off **my** ship!" **said** Black Hat Bob.

If your child is in a Read Write Inc. school or if you have bought a parent pack, the films will help you and your child practise together at home.





Which books will children bring home?



Please record each time you listen to your child read their book. It is important that your child reads the book and you listen. If your child struggles with a word ask them to use their Fred Talk.

Book Bag Books

- Extra reading practice at home
- Uniquely matched to the *Read Write Inc.* Phonics Storybooks.
- Reinforce children's learning of phonics at the appropriate level.
- Helps to make even faster progress in reading.



What can you do?

- Listen to your child read the same Storybook again and again. At least once a day.
- Encourage them to use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', 'read the word'
- Discuss the story and encourage their storyteller voice.
- Help your child to sound out the letters in words and then 'point and sweep' the sounds together to make a whole word. **Please do not refer to the letters by their names.**
- Help your child to focus on the 'pure' sounds. You can hear how to say the sounds correctly by searching on YouTube for 'Read Write Inc. Phonemes Pronunciation Guide'.


