

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term in Year 2.



MATHEMATICS MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION

This term, children will learn about multiplication and division through equal groups, arrays, grouping and sharing. They will use the \times and \div symbols and practise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Pupils will solve practical problems, use doubling and halving strategies, and apply their skills to real-life maths situations with growing confidence.



ENGLISH WRITING GRANDAD'S CAMPER

This term, children will explore Grandad's Camper by Harry Woodgate. They will begin by exploring a memory box linked to Grandad's travels. Children will reflect on how special objects hold important memories. They will develop descriptive writing using expanded noun phrases. Pupils will practise writing in the past progressive tense. They will write questions in role and create a postcard. The unit ends with planning and writing a sequel to the story.



HISTORY THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON

This term in History, children will learn about the Great Fire of London and how it changed the city. They will discover how the fire started in 1666 and why it spread so quickly. Children will explore what London was like at the time and learn about key events and people, including Samuel Pepys and the Lord Mayor. They will investigate the causes and impact of the fire, and find out how London was rebuilt afterwards, including the creation of the first fire services.



SCIENCE LIVING THINGS & THEIR HABITATS

This term in Science, children will learn about living things and their habitats. They will explore what makes something a living organism and understand the life processes all living things carry out. Pupils will investigate different habitats and microhabitats, learn how plants and animals are suited to their environments, and explore simple food chains to see how energy is passed from producers to consumers.



PSHE BEING RESPONSIBLE

This term in PSHE, children will learn about being responsible, showing good manners and self-respect. They will explore how to stay safe, recognise kind behaviour and understand the difference between responsible and irresponsible actions.



MUSIC CONTRASTING DYNAMICS

This term in Music, children will develop their singing and listening skills through creating vocal soundscapes, responding creatively to different pieces of music and comparing how music can sound and feel. They will explore pitch patterns, use their voices expressively and work together to create and perform their own simple musical structure, building confidence and teamwork.



RELIGIOUS AND WORLDVIEWS STORIES FROM THE BIBLE

This term in Religion and Worldviews, children will explore stories from the Bible to learn what Christians believe God is like. They will listen to stories about Jesus' actions and the parables he told, discussing ideas such as kindness, forgiveness, and making wise choices. Through talk and reflection, children will begin to understand why these stories are important to Christians.



COMPUTING TYPING SKILLS

This term in Computing, children will learn how to use spreadsheets to organise and present information. They will explore how to enter and edit data in 2Calculate, use tools and simple formulas to complete calculations, and create block graphs to represent data. Pupils will develop their understanding of rows, columns and cells, and learn how spreadsheets can be used to solve problems and answer questions.
