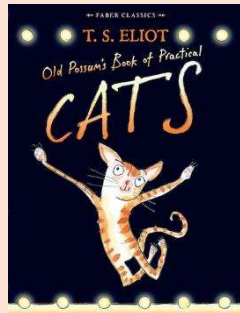
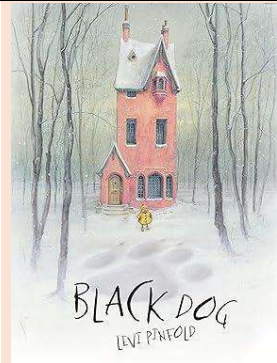


Term 4 Curriculum Overview

Year 3

Reading & Writing



In our Writing lessons this term, we will be spending the first two weeks participating in a whole-school writing root based upon Tom Percival's book 'Bridges'. Following this, Year 3 will be studying the story 'Black Dog' by Levi

Pinfold. As we study this text, we will discover what features create an effective suspenseful narrative, before having a go at writing our own. In our reading lessons this term, we will be moving on from the non-fiction 'Earth-shattering Events' to poetry in T.S Eliot's 'Old Possum's Book of Practical Cats'.

Maths

In our maths lessons this term, we are going to start by further developing our knowledge and fluency with multiplication and division, before moving on to applying this to new learning on fractions.

Science

In science this term we will continue to study biology, moving on to learning about the features of flowering plants and what they need to survive.

D&T

In Design & Technology this term we will be completing a textiles unit called 'Keeping It Contained', in which pupils will learn to apply different types of fasteners to fabric and will create a pouch to hold small everyday items.

Geography/History

This term we will be completing a history unit on Ancient Egypt. In this unit, pupils will learn about the role of the pharaoh in ancient Egypt, and will examine pyramids, mummification and conquest in the Egyptian empire.

Music

This term we will be learning to identify stylistic features of different genres, styles and traditions of music.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be learning about being responsible, looking at what responsibility means and ways in

Religion & Worldviews

This term we will be moving onto Theology and aiming to answer the question 'Where do Islamic beliefs come from?'. We will learn about the history of Prophet Muhammad, revelation of the Qur'an, and the significance of Makkah..

Computing

In computing this term we will be learning about coding. Pupils will explore timers, the repeat command and the importance of nesting code. They will build up to using design documentation to code a program.

Spanish

In Spanish this term we will be learning about following classroom instructions, naming classroom objects and exploring grammar rules such as masculine and feminine nouns, plurals, and forming a negative construction

PE

In PE this term we will be developing our balance, agility and coordination through dodgeball, and developing simple tactics for attacking and defending in hockey.
