

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term in Year 2.



MATHEMATICS FRACTIONS AND TIME

This term in Maths, children will learn about fractions and time. They will begin by exploring parts and wholes, including halves, quarters, and thirds, before finding fractions of shapes and amounts. They will then move on to telling the time on an analogue clock, starting with o'clock and half past, and progressing to quarter past, quarter to, and 5-minute intervals, as well as learning about minutes in an hour and hours in a day.



ENGLISH WRITING THE DRAGON MACHINE

This term in English, children will explore The Dragon Machine by Helen Ward, using it as a stimulus for a range of creative writing. They will develop their use of descriptive language, grammar, and vocabulary through activities such as letters, guides, and explanations. Throughout the unit, children will build up to writing their own fantasy story, inspired by themes of adventure, imagination, and belonging.



GEOGRAPHY RIVERS, SEAS AND OCEANS

This term in Geography, children will learn about rivers, seas, and oceans, exploring how water covers much of the Earth's surface. They will learn key features of rivers such as the source and mouth, and understand how rivers flow from highland to lowland areas. Children will also discover the difference between seas and oceans and how people use them for work and leisure, building their knowledge of the natural world.



SCIENCE SOLIDS, LIQUIDS AND GASES

This term in Science, children will learn about solids, liquids, and gases, understanding that everything is made of matter. They will explore the properties of each state and learn how materials can change, for example when water freezes into ice or turns into water vapour. Through simple observations and discussions, children will develop their understanding of how materials behave in the world around them.



PSHE BEING RESPONSIBLE

This term in PSHE, children will explore British Values, including democracy, rules, individual liberty, and tolerance. They will learn why rules matter, how to make fair choices, and how to respect others in their community.



MUSIC STRUCTURE

This term in Music, children will develop their understanding of rhythm and structure through the theme of Myths and Legends. They will practise reading, clapping, and writing rhythms, before creating, rehearsing, and performing their own simple compositions inspired by mythical stories.



RELIGIOUS AND WORLDVIEWS HINDU WORSHIP

This term in Religion and Worldviews, children will explore Hindu worship and what our senses can tell us about it. They will learn about key ideas such as Brahman and the Trimurti, and explore how Hindus worship at home and in a mandir. Through discussion and observation, children will begin to understand how sights, sounds, and smells are important in worship.



COMPUTING CODING

This term in Computing, children will learn about coding, creating simple programs using algorithms. They will explore how to control objects, use events such as clicks and collisions, and understand the importance of testing and debugging their work to make sure it runs correctly.
