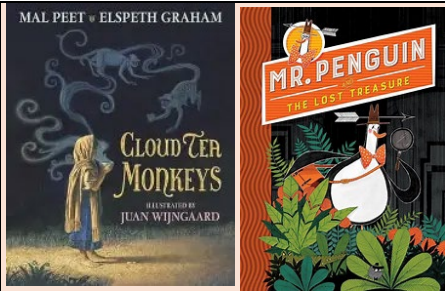


Term 5 Curriculum Overview

Year 3



Reading & Writing

In our Writing lessons this term, we will be writing a non-chronological report on tea inspired by the beautiful narrative 'Cloud Tea Monkeys' by Mal Peet and Elspeth Graham. Following this, Year 3 will be studying the story 'The Last Garden' by Rachel Ip, which we will be using to own narratives. In our reading lessons this term, we will be developing our inference and vocabulary skills, starting with reading the fictional narrative 'Mr Penguin and the Lost Treasure' by Alex T. Smith, before moving on to the nature-themed poetry anthology 'I am the Seed that Grew the Tree', collated by Fiona Waters.

Maths

In our maths lessons this term, we are going to start by further developing our knowledge and fluency with fractions, before moving on to learning about money and time.

Science

In science this term we will move on from biology to physics, learning about forces and motion. In this unit, we will be looking at push and pull forces, along with beginning to understand opposing and balancing forces.

D&T

In Design & Technology this term we will be studying food technology, applying learning about nutritional balance and food hygiene when making sandwiches with a balance of proteins, fats and carbohydrates.

Geography

This term, pupils will learn about the human and physical features found across Europe, with particular focus on tourism and it's impact in the Alps, the Amalfi Coast in Italy and the UK.

Music

This term we will be learning to about Jazz music, learning about ragtime music and exploring how to play a swung rhythm using percussion instruments.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be deepening our learning about feelings and emotions, learning about grief and consolidating learning on feelings and emotions from KS1. We will then move on to learning about how to look after our world

Religion & Worldviews

This term we will be learning about Islam, aiming to answer the question

Computing

In computing this term we will be learning about Presentations using

'How do Muslims express their beliefs in their daily lives?'. This term, we will learn about the expression of beliefs about Allah, Tawhid, and the lived diversity of the hijab.
