

Curriculum Overview

Please see what your child will be learning in their fifth term of Year 5 for the 2025/26 academic year.



Mathematics Statistics/ Shape/ Position and Direction

In Maths, we will be spending the term focusing on statistics. This involves reading and interpreting graphs and tables. We will then be moving on to a two week unit and shape as well as position and direction.



Writing Kasper Prince of Cats

Children will create a range of fiction and non fiction writing opportunities including letter writing, narrative writing an alternative ending, newspaper articles, recounts and researching The Titanic and its voyage.



Science Physics: Forces

This term, we will be learning about forces. This includes looking closely at weight and mass, friction, air resistance and water resistance. We will also be using our maths knowledge to look at area.



Geography Climate across the world

Looking at Climate Zones, examining climates using graphs and exploring climate change.



PSHE Growing and Changing

This term, we will be looking at puberty and reproduction. We will then move on to look at inclusion and acceptance.



Music Looping and Remixing

In music this term, we will be learning about looping and remixing. We will be using body percussion and loops to create a whole piece of music, working in groups.



Computing Game Creation

This term children will be learning how to use software on purple mash to create their own game.



Art Sculpture

This term we will be looking at sculpture, creating various pieces of art work based on birds.



Guided Reading Titanic

This engaging text, about what is perhaps the world's most famous of ships, has been expertly written and put together using information from multiple sources. Using fact boxes, photos, illustrations, an overall scrapbook style of presentation makes the text eye-catching and appealing for young readers. Subject-specific vocabulary will not only enhance the children's knowledge of this specific historical event, but also enable them to discuss other historical events from the time. The timeline used to present the chronological order of events paired with stories of courageous (and sometimes cowardly!) individuals, as well as artefacts, telegrams and photographs means that this is a perfect text through which to model a range of reading comprehension skills for children in the Upper Primary age phase.



Religion Christianity

In RE, we learn about lots of religions. In term 5, we will be continuing to look at Christianity. Children will be learning about the beliefs around Jesus and how these impacted art and music.



Spanish Celebrations

This term, we will be looking at Spanish celebrations, finding out about key festivals and celebrations. Children will be able to talk about what they like and do not like in regards to the celebrations we look at.
